
Steps to Complete the e-CRBA Application



Before completing your child's eCRBA application, make sure you have saved the following documents in a folder so you can upload all files at once:



- Indian Birth Certificate for the child.
- Marriage certificate.
- Documentation of previous marriage dissolution (if applicable):
 - i.e. Divorce decree or death certificate (save all pages of the divorce document as one single pdf attachment. Do not upload individual sheets.)
- Bio page of both parents' passports (or photo IDs if passport not available).
- Naturalization certificate (or Certificate of citizenship if applicable).
- If the U.S. citizen parent who is transmitting citizenship to the child is not present when applying for a CRBA, that parent should complete a Form DS-5507
- Proof of U.S. physical presence:
 - Bio page and *all* pages of U.S. citizen's previous Indian passport or foreign passports (attach as one pdf file) and current U.S. passports.
 - Transcripts from high school and/or college (if applicable)
 - Asylum paperwork (if applicable)
 - DD214 Separation Statement (for military veterans)

If the above documents are not available, then you can upload the following:

- credit card bills
- airline ticket stubs
- tax returns
- wage statements

How It Works

Good news! You're eligible to request a CRBA online. Here's how it works:

Step 1: Complete the CRBA application

Usually about 15-30 minutes



- Gather your <u>important documents</u> and upload copies as you go to save time later.
- Save your progress and return any time.
- Submit \$100 application fee then schedule your in-person interview with your local embassy or consulate.

Step 2: Attend your in-person interview

Usually about 1-2 hours



- Attend your scheduled in-person interview.
- Bring your original documents to your interview.
- If approved, arrange to pick up your CRBA or have it mailed to you by providing a pre-paid envelope. Find your local embassy or consulate <u>here</u>.



The information may also be provided to foreign government agencies, international organizations and, in limited cases, private persons and organizations to investigate, prosecute, or otherwise address possible violations of law or to further the Secretary's responsibility for the protection of U.S. nationals abroad. 
At the interview, you may be asked to provide proof of any precise periods of time you list, which could be bank statements, employment records, rent payments, school transcripts, utility bills, etc. Do not include any time after the child was born, and do not list any time spent outside of the U.S.








- Physical presence is the actual time the parent was physically located in the United States.
- Any periods of travel outside the United States (i.e., vacations, business trips, etc.) should NOT be included in the physical presence calculation.
- Physical presence in the United States can be any time before the child's birth.
- This can include time before the U.S. citizen parent was naturalized as a U.S. citizen.








Similarly enter the dates you entered and exited the United States till the birth of your child.

Upload your current and expired passports:

Bio page and *all* pages of previous and current passports. If you entered the United States on any Indian passports, upload the bio page and *all* pages of these passports.





Upload each passport separately to avoid confusion. For example, your Indian passport(s) with all pages can be saved as single pdf documents. Your US passport(s) with all pages should also be saved as single pdf attachments.



Other evidence you can upload:

- -transcripts from high school and/or college,
- wage statements
- DD214 Separation Statement (for military veterans) ---
- credit card bills
- airline ticket stubs
- immigration paperwork (i.e. asylum documents).




